Future Women's Camp is a girls' summer camp sponsored by Reformation Covenant Church in Oregon City, a member of the Confederation of Reformed Evangelical Churches.

The camp's goals are: to build godly character in its participants with Biblical teaching, to provide opportunity for the older women in the church to mentor the younger women, and to promote enjoyable fellowship amongst its participants.

The camp is geared toward two age groups: young women ages 13–20 and adult women who are interested in building relationships with and mentoring these younger women.

Future Women's Camp 2010 will be held at **Harbor Villa Retreat Center** in Rockaway, Oregon. Harbor Villa is an oceanfront facility run by Twin Rocks Friends Camp that is ideal for small retreat groups.

Lorna Arnold is an inspiring and passionate teacher who loves to open the minds of young people to the possibilities and wonders God has placed before them. Lorna has led numerous small group studies and Sunday school classes. She is a 20 year veteran homeschooler and has taught at Springfield Classical Christian School. Lorna's husband of 30 years, Lonnie Sr., is an elder at Faith Presbyterian Church who assists small, struggling churches in their ministry and does outreach to inner-city churches in Tacoma. Lonnie and Lorna have seven children ranging in age from 13 to 27, three of whom are now married.

Walking in Christ is the topic for RCC Future Women's Camp 2010. In her talks, Lorna will help her listeners examine their motivation for all that they do, focusing their thoughts on doing all things for Christ.
